ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION

OF WESTERN WHEELERS BICYCLE

The name of this corporation is Western Wheelers Bicycle Club.

ΙI

A. This corporation is a nonprofit mutual benefit corporation organized under the Nonprofit Mutual Benefit Corporation Law. The purpose of this corporation is to engage in any lawful act or activity for which a corporation may be organized under such law.

B. The specific purposes of this corporation are to:

- 1. Promote bicycle touring and arrange bicycle rides to fit the varying skills of its members.
- 2. Encourage and work for bicyclist education.
- 3. Work for planning and development of bikeways within cities and intra-city bike routes.
- Promote bicycling for recreation, health and pleasure, and as a means of transportation for commuting and shopping.
- 5. Study and assist in any way possible to further bicycling safety and prevent bicycle theft.

This corporation was previously an unincorporated association known as Western Wheelers Bicycle Club, which is being incorporated by the filing of these articles.
