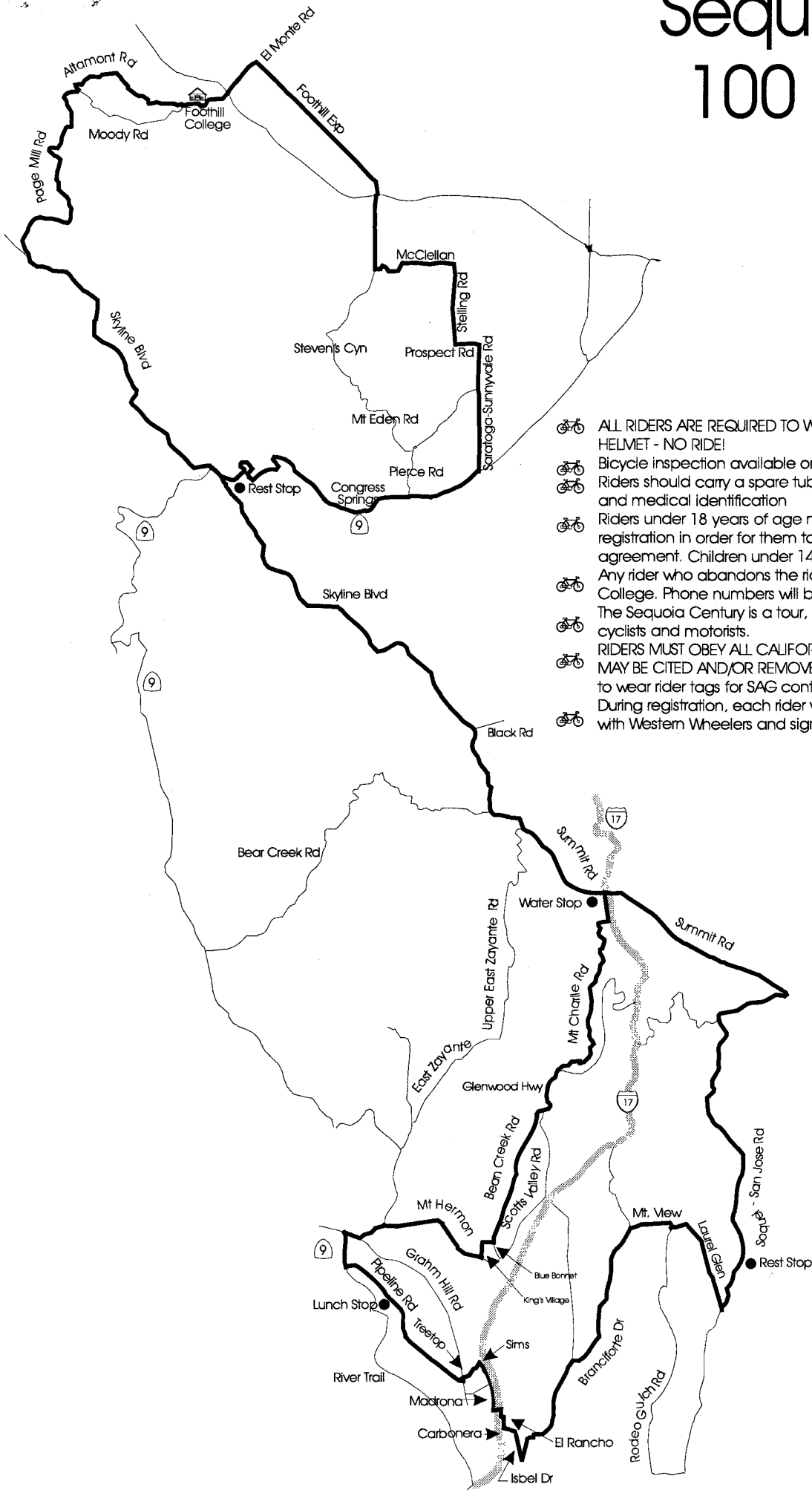










# Sequoia Century 100 Mile Route



-  ALL RIDERS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR ANSI OR SNELL APPROVED HELMETS... NO HELMET - NO RIDE!
-  Bicycle inspection available on a voluntary basis
-  Riders should carry a spare tube, pump, tools, water bottle, phone money, and medical identification
-  Riders under 18 years of age must have a parent or guardian present during registration in order for them to sign a medical authorization form and release agreement. Children under 14 years must ride with an adult.
-  Any rider who abandons the ride must notify ride headquarters at Foothill College. Phone numbers will be on route sheets.
-  The Sequoia Century is a tour, not a race. Please be courteous to other cyclists and motorists.
-  RIDERS MUST OBEY ALL CALIFORNIA VEHICLE CODE LAWS. THOSE WHO DON'T MAY BE CITED AND/OR REMOVED FROM THE RIDE. Participants will be required to wear rider tags for SAG control, law enforcement, and safety.
-  During registration, each rider will be required to sign a Release Agreement with Western Wheelers and sign a California Vehicle Code Safety Agreement.
