The Sequoia Century is a tour, not a race. Please be courteous to other cyclists and motorists. RIDERS MUST OBEY THE CALIFORNIA VEHICLE CODE. Those who don't may be cited and removed from the ride. Riders must wear rider tags for SAG control, law enforcement, and safety.
