Riders under 18 years old must have a parent or guardian present during registration to sign a medical authorization form and release agreement. Children under 14 years old must ride with an adult. The Sequoia Century is a tour, not a race. Please be courteous to other cyclists and motorists.

RIDERS MUST OBEY THE CALIFORNIA VEHICLE CODE. Those who don't may be cited and removed from the ride. Riders must wear rider tags for SAG control, law enforcement, and safety.
